SCHOOL BEHAVIOUR POLICY

We have attached the school behaviour policy as well as the child friendly version for you to look at. The children are aware that excellent behaviour is expected across all areas of school including lunchtimes. The children are expected to Shine and they know exactly what this means as each letter of the word Shine corresponds to an aspect of good behaviour. We have tried to keep our system as simple as possible so that all children have the opportunity to get it right. They are also aware of the sanctions if they do not follow the rules. Our children are not perfect but the vast majority of them respond well to the system with only the odd hiccup, which is to be expected!

Please take time to have a look at both versions and discuss with your child what they think.

In school we have worked hard to maintain our Healthy School status which was revalidated recently. Please could we remind parents and carers that children should only bring water to school in their bottles – no juice or fizzy drinks.

GOVERNOR PROFILE – KEVIN FORDE

My name is Kevin Forde and I am a Foundation Governor and vice-chair at Yeadon Westfield Infant School.

When my children were growing up, I had wanted to join the governing body of their school but had too much on my plate. My university alumni association got in touch during the summer 2020 to ask if I was interested in volunteering to join a school governing board. I attended a workshop to find out more and was then keen to get involved. I lived in Guiseley at the time so was really happy that the first school I was offered was nearby.

I gained a BEng in Electronics and then spent a 25 year career as a systems analyst and software developer working on large-scale projects like the Oyster card system used on the London Underground. I also had a business developing bespoke software for small businesses.

These days I have a business where I train and mentor people to start a business that is flexible and enables them to earn residual income. I now choose when I work which gives me the chance to spend at least one day a week with my grandchildren.
