



## National Child Measurement Programme (NCMP) and vision screening

All children in a Leeds reception class get an important health check whilst in school.

This is called the National Child Measurement Programme (NCMP) and vision screening.

We will measure and weigh your child fully clothed and do a distance vision screening.

Issues with either might affect your child's learning, development and achievements and is offered so we can spot any problems.

Your child's results will be sent to you. It will not be shared with the school without your consent. The results will be included in the letter and we will tell you if your child needs further eyesight tests. You may be asked to go to a local optician or your child may be referred to the Community Eye Clinic. **Please note the service does not screen for squints.** 

If your child is allergic to Durapore (surgical sticking tape), you want more information about the height, weight and eye screening or if you **DO NOT** want your child to have eye screening or be included in the NCMP programme, please telephone our 0-19 Admin SPA on **0113 843 5683** to tell us.
