		Visit our YouTube channel and listen to the story: The Treasure Of Pirate Frank		
Monday	Please look at our YouTube channel for specific phonics sessions.	Listen to the YouTube story <b>Write:</b> What happens in the story?	<b>Tin foil boats:</b> Make a boat out of tin foil. Find some objects. Predict how many objects it will take to sink the boat. Find out and remember to count!	<b>Make a treasure map!</b> This can be imaginary or a real map of somewhere you know. Make it look old by ripping the edges and rubbing a used tea bag over the finished map!
Tuesday	We are now on week 6 but all other phonics videos are there for you to use at your convenience.	Listen to the YouTube story- can you join in with the story? <b>Write:</b> How does the Boy feel?	<b>Treasure hunt:</b> adults to hide number cards 1-20 around the house. Children to find them and order them. Can they say one more and one less than a number?	<b>Build a pirate ship</b> out of cushions and blankets. Don't forget to have a plank! Where are you going to sail?
Wednesday	The sessions do follow on from each other but doing them as standalone sessions is also fine.	Listen to the YouTube story. Can you make up some actions to go with the story? <b>Write:</b> How does Captain Sally Frank feel?	<b>Money:</b> find some coins! Look closely at the coins. Do you recognise them? Can you do some simple addition? E.g. 5p + 2p = 7p	<b>Make a telescope:</b> decorate some paper and then roll it up! Look through your telescope and play I spy. I hope you don't spot any other pirates!
Thursday		Listen to the YouTube story <b>Write:</b> Can you find any pirate facts out?	<b>Pirate sharing:</b> Pretend you need to share your treasure with someone. Find some things to share in your house. This could be coins, pens, cereal, crisps or something else to eat. Once you have correctly shared your items you can get your reward and eat them!	<b>Treasure hunt:</b> Find something in your bedroom that you think would make good treasure. Now hide it really well and get someone to find it. You might need to think of some clues!
Friday		Listen to the YouTube story <b>Write:</b> What would you do if you were a pirate?	<b>Pirate adding:</b> Pirates need to be good at adding so they can count all their treasure! Can you work out the answer to these questions? 7+2= 6+4= 8+7= 5+3= 9+4= 4+4= Now make up some of your own. Make them as hard as you like!	<b>Crafts:</b> Make some pirate accessories! Every pirate needs a sword, an eye patch and a ship! Get crafty and make these things out of recycled food boxes. You could even wrap your sword in tinfoil to make it look sharp and shiny!
