Try writing them out.</p> <p>Measures: Today use your playdough to make lots of different egg shapes of different sizes. Put them in order of size from smallest to largest. Friday	Work on 'Green words' page of https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/api/digital_books/1220.html	<p>Design a Blackbird fact-file.</p> <p>You could:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> lay it out in sections, draw a blackbird outline and put your facts inside, put information in bubbles, display your information however you like! 	<p>Counting: Practise counting backwards!</p> <p>Learn its: continue with friends of 10 and 20 as above.</p> <p>Measures: Grab a ruler that measures in centimetres! Now, with your playdough can you make some wriggly worms for the blackbirds? They love worms! Can you make a worm that is 5cm long? One that is 10cm, 15 cm, 20cm, 25cm, 30cm? Can you put them in order of length?</p>	<p>Create a hatching egg!</p>
